**Ground Rules**

Garlynn presented a draft set of meeting guidelines for participation at meetings. The group discussed each topic and agreed to return to the issue at the May meeting.

**Portland Streetcar**

Dan Bauer provided an update and answered questions regarding planned streetcar expansion into Northeast. He reported that the priorities for expansion is into areas that will support development. He solicited feedback from the committee. Eliot Neighborhood Association supports the streetcar on MLK Boulevard. Sullivan's Gulch commented on the decoupling of Broadway and Weidler. Committee members noted that transit, not just the streetcar but also reliable bus service, is what stimulates development. Dan is working on a study to address holistic transportation models rather than modal ones (bike lanes vs. cars, transit, etc.)

**Update: Leslie Lum, Bureau of Planning and Sustainability**

Leslie provided updates on the 2035 Comprehensive Plan Map Refinement project and connected code refinements to reconcile technical changes, including within neighborhoods and around homeless populations.
