**Call to Order, Minutes**

The committee approved the September 27, 2017 minutes as presented. **Motion/Second/Carried (MSC) Woodsong/Schweitzer.**

**Committee Guidelines and Priorities**

The committee reviewed the agreed-upon meeting guidelines for discussions and presenters and the status of current priorities.

**N/NE Broadway Planning Presentation**

Clay Veka and Nick Falbo gave a presentation on the background and elements on the various past and current City plans affecting the development of safety and active transportation infrastructure and redesign on NE Broadway, including the 1996 Broadway Weidler Corridor Plan and the 2016 Transportation System Plan (TSP) and Vision Zero Action Plan. PBOT identified NE Broadway as a High Crash Network through the Vision Zero Action Plan; people walking and biking are twice as likely to be hit by a motor vehicle in this corridor than on other streets of Portland. In order to address speed limits and other safety improvements, the City will need to update the 1996 Corridor Plan and consider Business District designation at the state level. After discussion, the committee agreed to send a letter in support of an updated plan that incorporates the Vision Zero Action Plan's recommendations on street designs, speed, and dangerous behaviors to create a street that is safe for all Portlanders. **MSC Woodsong/Ehelebe.**
